

Directions to The Trust Company
4823 Old Kingston Pike, Suite 100, Knoxville, TN 37919

From the west: Take I-40 to the Northshore/Papermill exit 383. Turn right on Northshore Drive. Go to Kingston Pike and turn left. Go 1.2 miles to the light at Forest Park Blvd., just past Mayo's Garden Center. Turn right on Forest Park Blvd. Take the first right onto Old Kingston Pike. The Trust Company is in the last building on the right.

From the east: Take I-40 to the Alcoa Highway exit 386B. Take the ramp to Kingston Pike and turn right. Go 2.2 miles until you see a Regions Bank on your left. Turn left just before the Regions Bank onto Old Kingston Pike. The Trust Company is in the last building on the right.

From South Knoxville: As long as the Henley Bridge remains closed, anyone coming from the south will probably have their own favored route to get across the river. If they know how to get onto Kingston Pike westbound, give them the last part of the "from the east" directions above. If not, use the "downtown" directions below.

From Downtown Knoxville: Take Cumberland Avenue west through the UT campus and continue on it after Alcoa Highway, where it becomes Kingston Pike. Continue 2.2 miles past Alcoa Highway until you see a Regions Bank on your left. Turn left just before the Regions Bank onto Old Kingston Pike. The Trust Company is in the last building on the right.

From the Airport: Follow signs to Alcoa Highway (US 129) northbound. After crossing the Tennessee River, take the Neyland Drive ramp toward the University. Turn right from the ramp and go to the traffic light at Kingston Pike. Turn left onto Kingston Pike. Go 2.2 miles until you see a Regions Bank on your left. Turn left just before the Regions Bank onto Old Kingston Pike. The Trust Company is in the last building on the right.

From neighborhoods to the south (coming in on Lyons View Pike): Turn left on Colony Street just before you get to Kingston Pike, go to the stop sign and turn left onto Old Kingston Pike. The Trust Company is in the last building on the right.

For people who are reasonably familiar with the area, we are "near Long's Drug Store" and "next door to WIVK" and "in the same part of town as the Fresh Market." Whatever you do, don't tell anyone to just go to Mayo's on Kingston Pike. There are TWO Mayo's on Kingston Pike, and the other one is a long ways from here!
